
Family Activity Day is for everyone. You are encouraged to "adopt" friends and neighbors who would enjoy an evening of family activities.

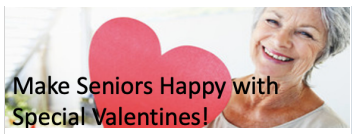
